Pure Perfection from Schrader

In 2000, vintner Fred Schrader plucked a young winemaker named Thomas Rivers Brown out of a Napa Valley wine shop, recruiting him to his nascent Schrader Cellars. Their shared goal: to make “no holds barred” wines of the highest caliber.

Today, the Schrader-Brown partnership is one of the most successful in Napa Valley history. The lucky winner of this historic lot will take home an EXTREMELY rare collection of Schrader CCS Cabernet Sauvignon from the Beckstoffer To Kalon Vineyard: Three (3) double-magnums straight from the cellar of winemaker Thomas Rivers Brown, all autographed by Brown himself—and all of which hold perfect 100-point ratings from Robert Parker.

Parker said Schrader’s CCS is a wine that “always seems to hit all the sweet spots on my palate,” and is therefore “a wine that I tend to give more perfect scores to than of the other Schrader offerings.” These three flawless bottles will anchor your cellar for decades to come.
