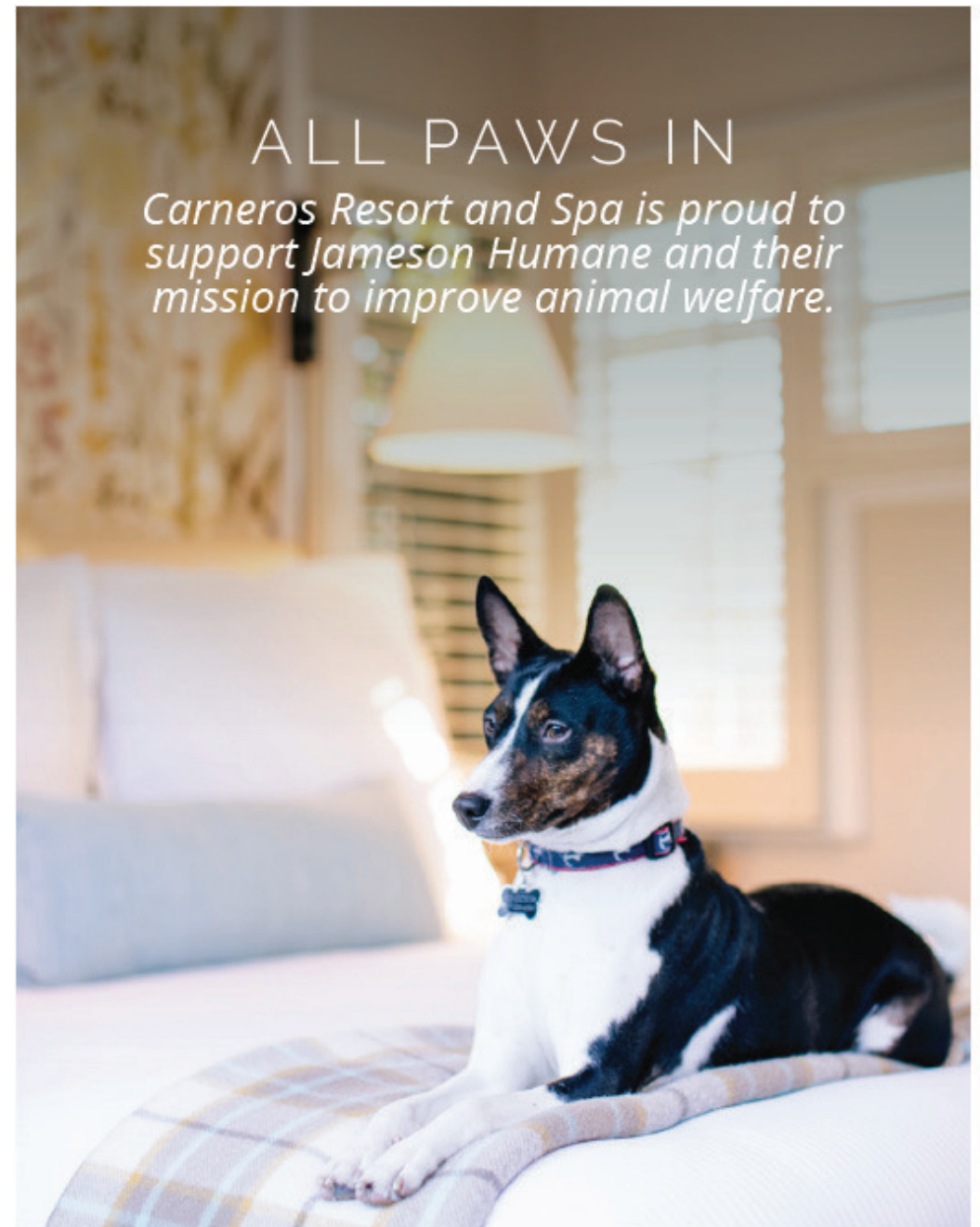

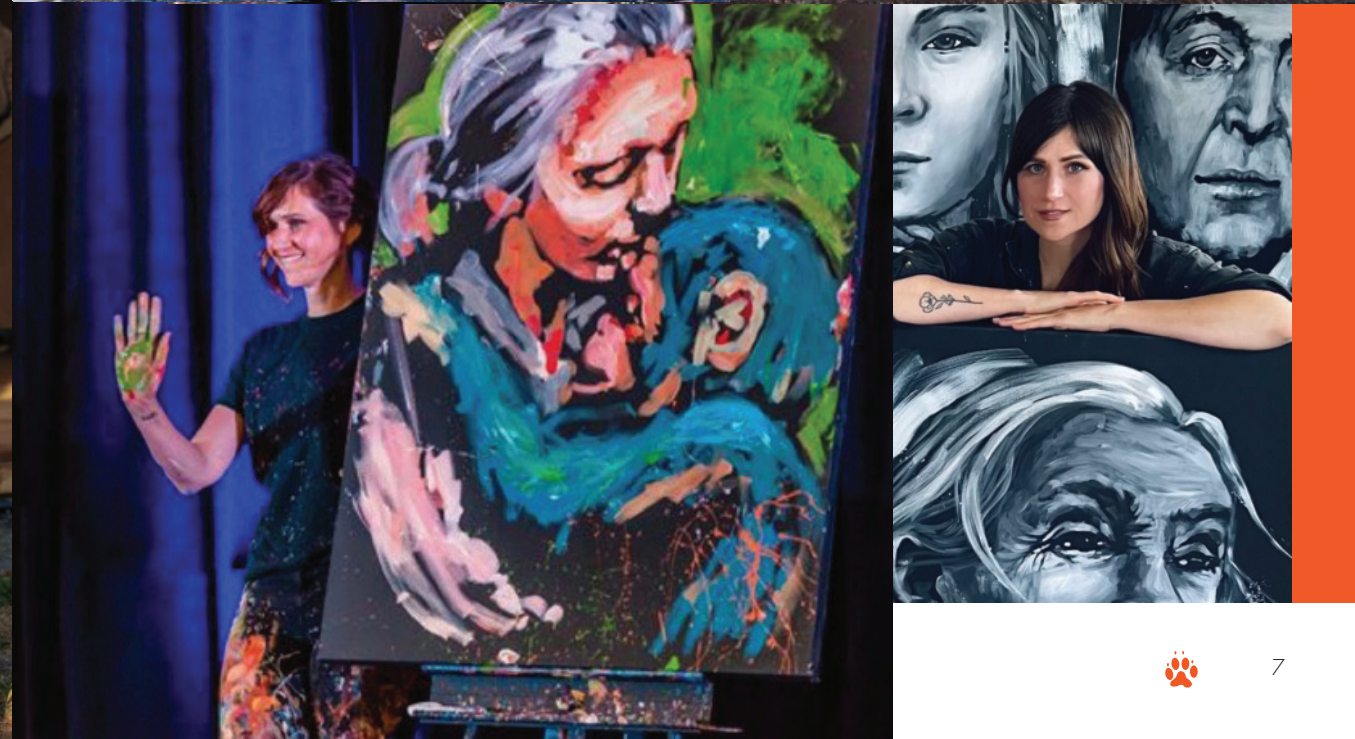




## Amy Burkman: Artist for the Animals

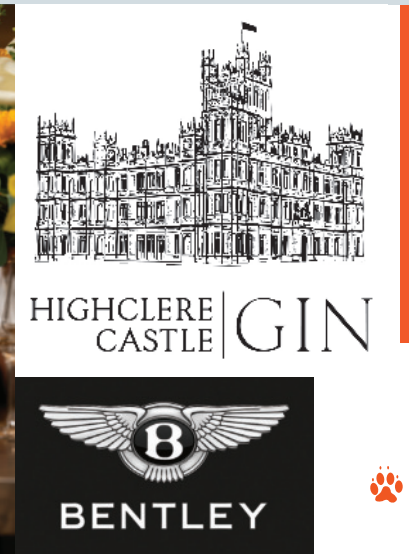

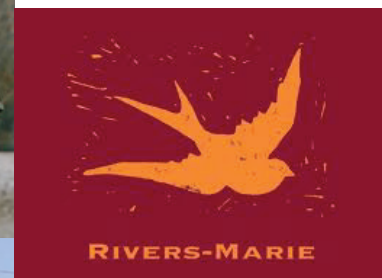
