As part of WineaPAWlooza 2020, we are very proud to pay tribute to Napa Valley icons, Andy and Betty Beckstoffer, and celebrate Beckstoffer Vineyards' 50 years of grape growing, farming, and commitment to Napa Valley. Beckstoffer Vineyards' became the largest independent grape growers in Napa Valley and the North Coast of California (Napa, Sonoma, Mendocino, and Lake Counties), owning 4,000 vine acres, employing some 195 people full time, and is the largest seller of premium wine grapes, selling to over 150 wineries annually. From being awarded the St. Helena Citizens of the Year award in 2001, to the Acre by Acre Award in 2014, to coverage in the New York Times in 2020, few leaders have made a larger impact on the evolution of Northern California's wine industry.

As one of the earliest and most important leaders in this world-class grape-growing region, Andy and Betty have a passion for ensuring the exceptional care of not only animals, but for farmers and the land. "Because of [Andy and Betty Beckstoffer's] generosity and their commitment to Napa County, more than 400 acres of land will be protected forever," - U.S. Rep. Mike Thompson

No wine makes Napa Valley's most precious parcel shine brighter than Old Sparky: Schrader Cellars' electrifying Beckstoffer To Kalon-grown Cabernet, which hits 100 more than Calistoga in August—and every single wine in this six-magnum lot boasts a perfect score from Robert Parker's *Wine Advocate*.

These flawless, large-format bottles (from the 2006, 2008, 2012, 2013, 2015 and 2016 vintages) are all signed by winemaker Thomas Rivers Brown, and come straight from the cellars of Brown, Carol Schrader, and Dean and Laurie Gray and Steve Nordhoff (of Riverain).

How good are these wines? Over the years, the critics have described them as “pure hedonism,” and simply, “as great as Cabernet can be.” They might just ruin you for other wines—and it will be well worth it.

Think you've gone wild in wine country? Not until you've spent a debaucherous weekend in the orbit of three of Napa Valley's most fun-loving luminaries. Reassure your better half it's only for one weekend, and believe us, one weekend with this hedonistic trio is more than enough.

The wine world knows these three men for their work: Oscar Renteria is one of the most accomplished grapegrowers in the Valley, Kirk Venge is a 100-point Cabernet magic man, and Richard Vonsaal has designed some of Napa Valley and the country's most stunning spaces. Valley locals, on the other hand, know them for the off-the-charts ostentatious good time that follows them wherever they go.

On this weekend, 6 guys or gals (or whomever's got the mettle) get a rare peek at how these legends do what they do, at work and at play. First, you'll partake in a blending session with Kirk at Venge Vineyards, followed by a tasting and vineyard lunch. The next day, you'll spend the morning in the vines with Oscar and his team, followed by a collector tasting of his Tres Perlas wines at Brown Ranch Vineyard, then an authentic Mexican lunch and tequila tasting "as you might know, any day that ends with a tequila tasting never ends with the tequila tasting".

You'll wrap the weekend in true Napa Valley style with a dinner at Richard's design studio, a night that's guaranteed to be just like his work and the man himself: off the charts and over the top. From costumes to burlesque, nothing's ever out of bounds when Richard's in the room, so bring some Advil—and leave your smartphone and your inhibitions in your room.

You've been warned. This trio is ready to party and give you an unforgettable glimpse of a Napa Valley hedonism that few see—and even fewer survive.

Over his fifty years of farming, Andy Beckstoffer has supplied incomparable Cabernet Sauvignon from his Heritage Vineyards—Bourn, To Kalon, Dr. Crane, Las Piedras, George III, and Missouri Hopper—to the top wineries in Napa Valley. After decades supplying the most celebrated producers in the Valley, the Beckstoffer name is solid gold.

This year, the Wineries have donated fifteen (yes, 15!) double-magnums of Beckstoffer-bred wine from their cellars: We're talking Alpha Omega, Fait Main Morlet, Macauley, and TOR, and many more. Wine Advocate hundred-pointers? They're in there, along with more 98- and 99-pointers than you'll know what to do with. Our advice: figure out who your friends are now, because you'll be fighting off the whole neighborhood once they sniff out the lake of prime Beckstoffer wine in your cellar.

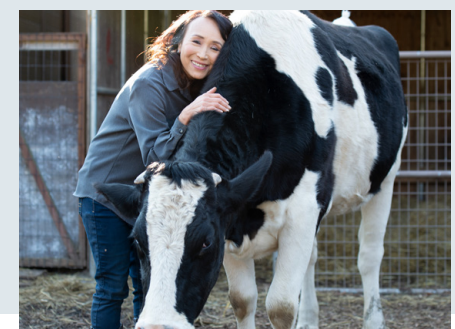

No need to dress this lot up: it's three double-magnums of Screaming Eagle, from the vintages that put the legendary Oakville Cabernet on the map: 1995, 1996, and the mythical 1997, a wine that Robert Parker stated plainly: "It doesn't get any better than 1997 Cabernet Sauvignon, a perfect wine."

Big bottles age gracefully, and time has been working its slow-motion magic on these double-mags as they've slumbered in Screaming Eagle founder Jeannie Phillips' cellar more than twenty years. It's hard to imagine these gems being anything less than sublime.

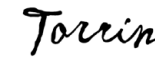

This is truly the best of the best in Paso, so think First Growths in Bordeaux and Grand Cru vineyards in Burgundy. Think you're just going to taste wine? Absolutely NOT! Each couple will leave with a magnum from each winery, some of whom only offer magnums for charitable causes, so don't even think you'll find this set anywhere else.

Paso's power has even pulled Napa Valley winemaking legend and Realm Cellars founder Juan Mercado down the coast to begin his next exciting project, and you'll join him and Greg Gregory, collector and wine industry insider, for a dinner at Les Petites Canailles by former Guy Savoy Michelin starred chef Julien Asseo. It'll be the perfect ending to a weekend that will cement Paso's place on your must-return wine map.

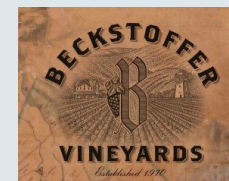

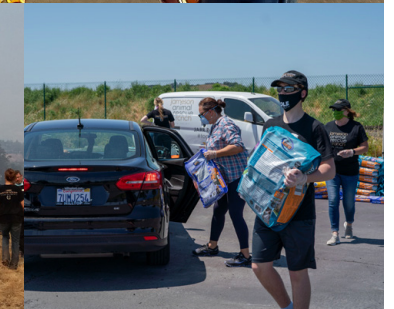

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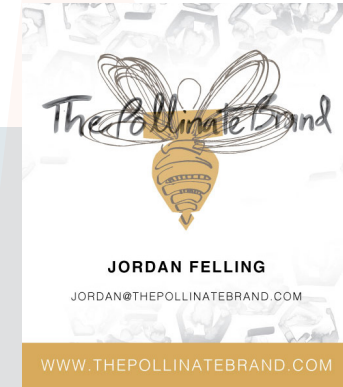
