

The critical supplies and equipment we're raising money for include:

- Animal Search and Rescue Equipment and Supplies that will support all CART Volunteers in three Counties
- Fireline Personal Protective Equipment for that will support all CART Volunteers in three Counties
- Mobile Veterinary Trailer to treat burned and injured animals on site
- Mobile Command Center to increase much needed communications throughout the region during disasters
- Response and Training Building Supplies for the Incident Command Center at Jameson Humane

The government is not able to fund animal response during disasters. BUT TOGETHER WE CAN! As the nexus between rescue groups—the CART teams, the CERT teams, law enforcement, first responders and firefighters —it is critical that we are prepared for the next time disaster strikes.
